If you checked "YES" for fever AND one or more of the other symptoms, keep you child at home because of an influenza-like illness. Any child with influenza-like symptoms must not board the bus or enter Camp Buckner's facilities to prevent the spread of the H1N1 virus, commonly referred to as Swine Flu. Current recommendation is that children remain home for seven days after symptoms start, even if the child is no longer ill. If you have questions about your child's health or symptoms, you should contact your child's healthcare provider for more information.

If your child begins exhibiting any of the above listed symptoms while at Camp Buckner, you will be immediately notified and you will need to make the necessary arrangements to pick your child up from Camp within 24 hours of notification in order to help prevent the spread of the virus. Once you are notified you will have the option to request that we send your child to the nearest health care clinic to receive care by a physician at your own expense. Buckner will not be responsible for providing health care to your child while at Camp.
